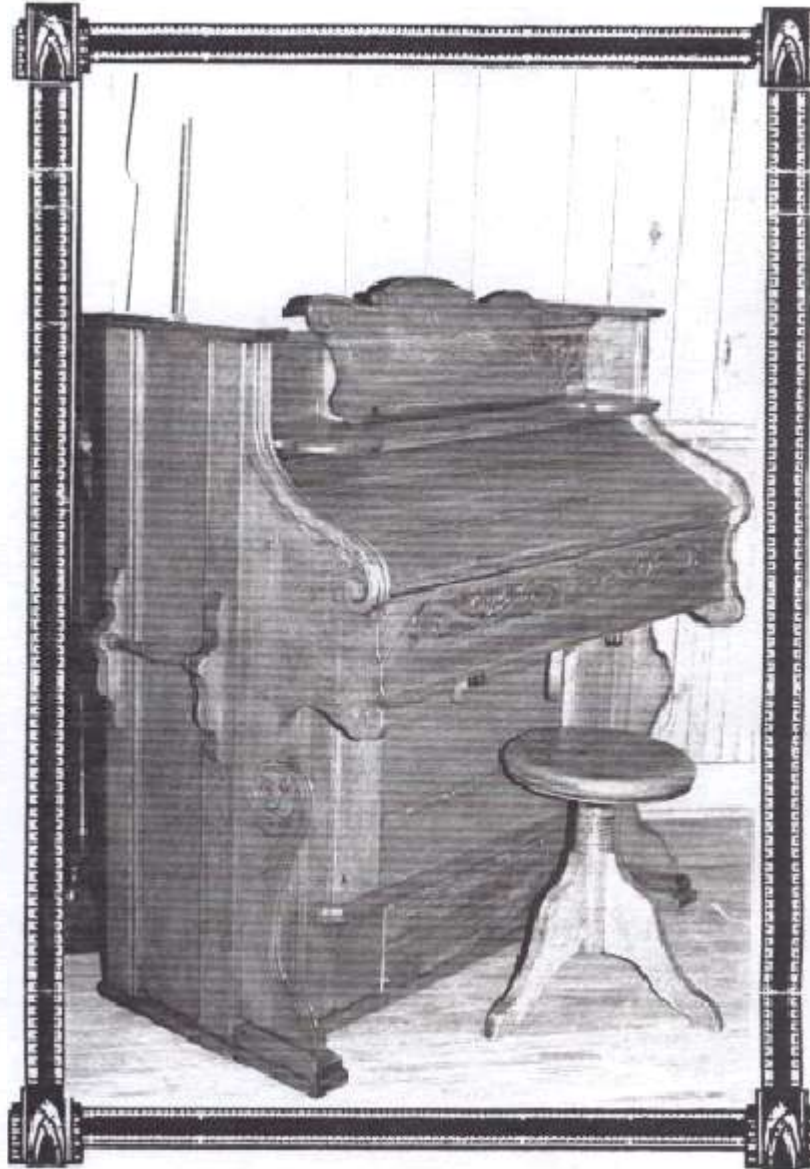
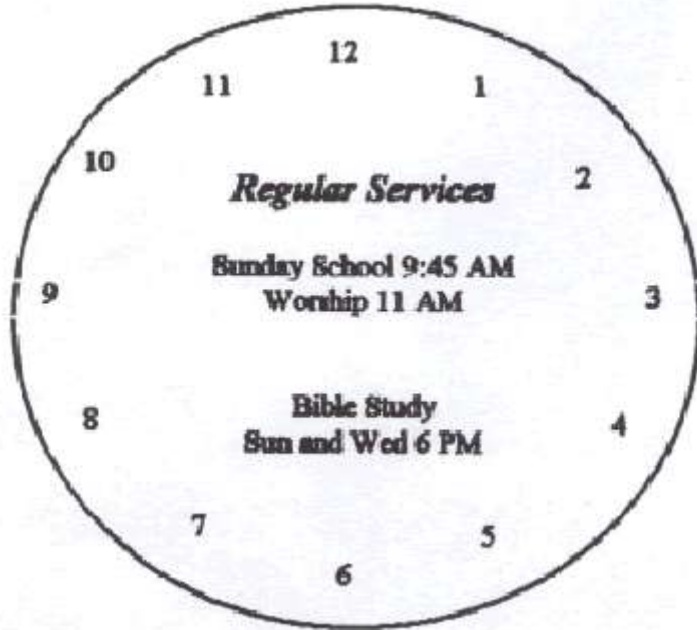

An old organ has been in the Diamond Valley building for years and no one seems to know from where it came.

Although it was originally a pump organ, it was converted to electric and has required repair many times due to mistreatment, neglect, or "rodent housing and cafe" syndrome.
